

Shelter, Inc. – A residence organization founded to prevent homelessness and promote self sufficiency in Martinez. Armanino employees will perform indoor and outdoor work including planting, weed abatement and other landscaping duties. Indoors, employees will organize donated items and arrange kits with personal affects for residents.

Onlok, Inc. – An organization based in San Francisco and founded by a group of citizens concerned about the plight of elders and the lack of long-term options in the community. The organization provides one-on-one and group interaction for seniors primarily in the Chinese community. Armanino volunteers – seven of whom speak Mandarin Chinese – will spend time with elderly members creating arts, crafts and later will conduct an ice-cream social and sing-along.

Boys & Girls Club of Silicon Valley – The Boys & Girls Club of Silicon Valley is a nonprofit, nationally recognized program of innovative and effective youth development. Serving over 3,000 members ages 6 to 18 at 7 facilities in North, East and South San Jose and two after school programs in Milpitas. Armanino employees will prepare and serve food for people in need in San Jose.

Second Harvest Food Bank – Second Harvest Food Bank of Santa Clara and San Mateo Counties is the single largest nonprofit provider of food to low-income households in Santa Clara and San Mateo Counties and are the seventh largest food bank in the country. The organization is in a newly renovated 22,000 square foot warehouse in San Carlos to distribute food. 20 Armanino employees will prepare and serve food for clients of the food bank.

John Muir: O’Neill House – At the historic home of Eugene O’Neill, America’s only Nobel Prize winning playwright, in Danville, 20 Armanino employees will perform landscaping duties.

Meals on Wheels – Meals on Wheels of San Francisco alleviates the food insecurity and loneliness experienced by seniors who want to stay in their own home but cannot shop or prepare meals for themselves. 15 Armanino volunteers will spend the day making personal cards, bringing a personal touch to senior clients who are unable to leave their homes. Meals on Wheels officials say they frequently hear from their clients how important these cards are to bring some meaning to their lives.

Loaves & Fishes, San Jose – An organization serving more than 1,000 meals per week to the walking poor, families, the homeless and shut-ins, who live in and around the downtown and East Side of San Jose. Armanino employees will prepare and serve food, then provide clean up services.

Glide Memorial Church, San Francisco – This is Cecil William’s famous congregation, which serves the residents of San Francisco’s Tenderloin District with meals and shelter. At Glide, Armanino employees will serve meals and perform general assistance tasks.

Anka Behavioral Health, Concord -- A pioneering nonprofit organization that provides life-changing behavioral health care services to some of California's most vulnerable residents. Anka operates a residential facility for short stay (2-3 weeks) for residents that are mentally disabled and physically disabled. Armanino employees will provide gardening help and do light construction tasks.

Junior Achievement -- Junior Achievement is the nation's largest provider of economic education for young people. This arm of the organization is in Martinez, working with grade school children. Armanino employees will teach pre-set courses to grade school children.

Easter Seals Bay Area, Dublin – Easter Seals helps individuals and families with disabilities and special needs live better lives. Services enable individuals with disabilities to address life's challenges, achieve personal goals and simply gain greater independence for everyday living. Employees from Armanino McKenna will do yard work and light construction tasks.

Tony La Russa's Animal Rescue Foundation, Walnut Creek – This animal shelter saves the lives of countless animals each year whose time has run out in public shelters and who are scheduled to be killed. Armanino employees will perform yard keeping tasks at the animal shelter.

San Damiano Retreat Center, Danville -- A Spanish-style Franciscan retreat center with a gift shop/bookstore, 76 bedrooms, 5 large meeting rooms, commercial kitchen and dining room, located on 50 acres in Danville Hills. The center serves all types of groups and individuals for private or topic-oriented retreats. Employees of Armanino McKenna will do grounds keeping tasks and refinish a number of garden benches.
